This is a general list. Keep in mind that individual teachers may request additional items. Please bring these items to Meet & Greet (Aug. 6 at 1:30pm) or the first day of school.

First Grade

- 2 spiral notebooks (wide-rule, 100 pages)
- 3 boxes of tissues
- 2 dozen #2 pencils (prefer Dixon Ticonderoga or Paper Mate Naturals)
- 2 boxes of crayons (24 count)
- 2 large glue sticks
- 1 pair Fiskars scissors
- 1 (1 inch) hardback 3-ring binder
- 2 blue/black dry erase markers (low odor)
- 1 pack of Post-It notes
- 1 pack of eraser caps
- 1 ream of white copy paper
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer (pump)
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes
- Boys: 1 box Ziploc gallon bags
- Girls: 1 box Ziploc sandwich bags (please no slide lock bags)

***Please do NOT send in Trapper Keepers, pencil sharpeners or pencil boxes*

Second Grade

- 8-10 pencils (wooden-sharpened)
- 1 plastic pencil box
- 1 eraser (Pink Pearl or Pedigree)
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1 4oz. Elmer's type glue

- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 plastic pocket folders
- 2 spiral notebooks (single subject – wide ruled)

- 2 dry erase markers (low odor)
- Individual pencil sharpener (not a toy)
- 2 highlighters
- 1 box of tissues
- Disinfectant wipes
- Boys only - 1 bottle of instant hand sanitizer
- Girls only – 2 packages of wide ruled loose leaf paper

Third Grade

- 2 packs of 24 wooden #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils)
- 1 eraser (Pink Pearl or Pedigree)
- 1 pack of eraser caps
- Wide-ruled loose-leaf notebook paper
- 1 box of 24 Crayola crayons
- 1 pack of sharpened colored pencils
- Individual pencil sharpener
- 2 yellow highlighters
- 1 4oz bottle Elmer's Glue
- 5 Elmer's Glue sticks
- 1 pair of Fiskars scissors
- 1 large box of tissues
- 1 roll of paper towels
- Disinfectant-type wipes
- 2 black fine point Sharpie markers
- 2 black extra-fine point or ultra-fine point Sharpie markers
- Expo Markers –regular size (not fine point)
- Memory Stick

Fourth Grade

- 4 large glue sticks
- 3 pkgs. wide-ruled notebook paper
- 1 fun folder to keep notebook paper in desk
- 3 boxes of #2 pencils
- 1 box of sharpened colored pencils (12-16)
- 1 pair Fiskars scissors
- 2 highlighters (one yellow/one pink)
- 3 composition notebooks
- 3 large boxes of tissues
- 1 pack Crayola original skinny color markers
- 1 roll paper towels
- 1 fine point Expo Marker –blue or black
- 2 packs of ruled 3 x 5 index cards
- 2 packs of 3 x 3 post it notes
- 1 pencil box –no larger than 9” x 6”
- 1 package dry erase markers
- 1 black sharpie marker –fine point
- 2 red stick pens (non-click type)
- Multiplication flash cards –students must be fluent before school begins
- 6 (3 prong) plain paper folders with pockets on inside one each of orange, blue, green, yellow, red & purple
- 1 box of ziplock bags –girls quart or gallon size, boys sandwich size
- 1 hand sanitizer –boys only
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes –girls only
- Students will purchase recorder at Meet & Greet. Please do not purchase recorders from the dollar store.

Fifth Grade

- Five red ink pens
- One zippered pencil pocket to use in **3 ring binder we will provide**
- Five packages loose leaf notebook paper, **wide-ruled**
- One package of dividers with tabs, 8 subjects
- Supply of #2 wooden (not plastic) pencils and **no mechanical pencils**
- Ten pocket folders, with pockets and brads
- One pair Fiskars **student scissors** with pointed edge (2 ½ inch blade)
- One box of crayons, 24 count
- One box of colored pencils

Fifth Grade Continued

- Two black Sharpie marking pens
- Two boxes of large (over 100 count) tissues
- Five composition books (sewn, not wire-spiraled) no smaller than 9 ¾ X 7 ½ inches
- One highlighter
- One large eraser
- Three large glue sticks
- Two rolls of paper towels
- One 8oz. instant hand sanitizer (boys)
- One container Clorox or other brand disinfecting wipes (girls)
- One package **Post-it flags**, 100 count-five colors (**NOT** Post-it notes)
- One memory flash drive (**may use the one from 4th grade**) for technology projects
- One individual pencil sharpener, with enclosure to catch the shavings

Kindergarten

- 1 dozen #2 pencils (prefer Dixon Ticonderoga)
- 4 boxes of 24 count Crayola brand crayons
- 1 set of 8-color Crayola washable watercolor paints
- 2 sets of Crayola markers – 1 fine point and 1 regular
- 6 large white glue sticks
- 1 ream of white copy paper
- Low odor dry erase markers
- 1 pack of 3x5 white index cards
- Paper towels
- 2 boxes of soft tissues
- 1 bottle of instant hand sanitizer (pump)
- 1 bottle of liquid hand soap (pump)
- Play-Doh
- 1 boxed 24-63 piece puzzle
- 1 standard sized backpack
- Disinfectant-type wipes
- Baby wipes
